This professional level programme is designed to support mastery of a range of complex and advanced facilitation capabilities in real world education and business settings. You will select a real world project or work activity to focus on in this programme and investigate under supervision the effectiveness of your facilitation practice, then analyse and record feedback, feed forward and the overall effectiveness of your facilitation. This programme will increase your experience and ability to facilitate effectively in challenging situations. Graduates of this programme will be able to advance their facilitation capabilities to the level where they can support the achievement of complex changes and outcomes with diverse people, and report back in a professionally honest and ethical manner to others.

### **Entry Criteria**

All applicants will complete an application form and may be interviewed before their place may be confirmed on this programme.

Programme start dates: January, April, July and October of each year.

## **Programme Length:**

This programme is offered part-time over 20 weeks.
