

Programme Aim

The aim of this programme is to develop curriculum designer project management capabilities and the capacity to lead re-developments and programme designs with and for diverse stakeholders where the designer carries responsibility for the programme outcomes. A range of project management process options are introduced and selected from along with one of several leadership approaches. A practical project is carried out in this programme to hone capabilities. Graduates of this programme will be able to manage a re-development or programme design project and provide effective leadership to others during this process.

Entry Criteria

All applicants will complete an application form and may be interviewed before their place may be confirmed on this programme.

Programme start dates: January, April, July and October of each year.

Programme Length:

This programme is offered part-time over 20 weeks.
